Welcome to Year 1 Spring Term 1

This half term our topic is Castles, Kings and Queens. In Geography will be learning all about the United Kingdom, the 4 countries that make it and the capital cities of each country as well as finding out about the seas that surround the United Kingdom.

Alongside this, we are looking at the text *Where the Wild Things Are* in English "*When a boat appears, Max sails to the land of the wild things, where he finds huge, multicoloured monsters with big claws and teeth. Not frightened of anything, Max tames the wild things, who agree that he is the wildest of them all, and make him their king.*" This term our vehicle text is going to be used to inspire our classes to write their own portal narrative where a character travels to a new land and then non – chronological text about the Wild Things.

In Maths we will be using our knowledge of place value to 20 to help us solve addition and subtraction calculations using different methods and representations. We will then start looking at the place value of numbers up to 50.

During our Science lessons this term we will be learning all about everyday materials, we will name them, sort them and explore their properties.

How you can support your child at home

Please continue to support your child in learning how to read and spell these words.
